Akhalkalaki HPP Project One Pager - # 5

Akhalkalaki HPP (the "Project") is a greenfield hydropower plant, located on Paravani and Korkhi Rivers in Samtskhe-Javakheti Region of Georgia, in Akhalkalaki Municipality. The Project consists of two separate intake structures, two buried penstocks and two surface powerhouses with a mutual grid connection solution. The Project's total installed capacity is 9.1MW and annual generation is about 49GWh. The project will use water from both Paravani and Korkhi Rivers and the outlet water will go back to Paravani River upstream of the existing Paravani HPP. Generated electricity will be connected to the national grid via new 35kV transmission line. In order to ensure that the voice of the community on a grass root level is strongly heard, Company offered Project Affected Communities (PAC) to select community members as delegates. Delegates are the focal points in the implementation of Social Projects, as well as support function for the company to outreach community members in various cases.

The Developer "AIS LLC" is committed to implement Akhalkalaki HPP Project to world class standards by minimizing environmental and social impacts of the construction, and zero harm to the local population, the same is requested from all Contractors during execution of the work.

Social Program

"AIS LLC" intends to improve its contribution to the sustainable development of the PAC by construction of various social projects, which are implemented with the vison to bring positive socio-economic changes to the communities.

Despite the fact that the company does not have any legal requirements, it is company's good will to support communities in the process of their development and creating better opportunities for their growth.




Employment of local population

Stakeholder engagement

Meetings with the PAC members, trustees, village delegates, and the Municipality representatives are being conducted regularly. In Q2 of 2022 in total 14 meetings were conducted with village residents and mayor's representatives of the project affected communities, Head of Akhalkalaki city council, and amenity service department.









In order to prevent any concern or complaint, and help resolving them in an amicable way, the Company has established a grievance mechanism to receive and handle stakeholders' grievances and concerns.

The Project's grievance mechanism is open to all stakeholders. They can provide grievances to the Company ESG manager and CLO in a verbal or written form via email, telephone or face to face meeting.

We care about children

The Company is committed to continuous effort to identify and eliminate or manage safety risks associated with its activities and, in general, to continuous improvement of its performance in health and safety not only at the Project level but at the community level as well.

Children are one of the most important stakeholder group for the Company. They are curious and tend to explore, but they cannot assess risks; To prevent the risks and raise the safety awareness, AIS LLC launched" School Safety" trainings in Project Affected Community with the agreement of Ministry of Education and Science of Georgia, Akhalkalaki Resource Center and Project Affected Community schools.

The training was created especially for children, based on the principle of "Play and Learn", and is based on child friendly syllabus. The training introduced subjects like what is HPP, safety during construction works, road safety, issues related to safe swimming, and COVID-19 related mitigation measures.

"School Safety" trainings were conducted in June 2021, (June 8,9 and 10). In total 220 school child participated in the trainings, from grad 2 to grad 8 in 4 schools of PACs Diliska, Korkhi and Orja.
